#### Background

In 2011, the States of Delaware, Maryland, and West Virginia and the Commonwealths of Pennsylvania and Virginia — five states with a history of close cooperation — established the Mid-Atlantic Consortium for Interoperable Nationwide Advanced Communications (MACINAC). #### FirstNet and MACINAC: One Mission - One Goal




